- Potential to contribute to the forestry industry in the Eastland region

### SELECTION PROCESS

Applications will be reviewed. You may be required to attend an interview. Recipients will be presented with their scholarship at the Annual Eastland Wood Council Forestry Awards on the 17<sup>th</sup> May 2019.

### SCHOLARSHIP REGULATIONS

- Eastland Wood Council is not obliged to offer a scholarship if, in any year, there is no candidate of sufficient merit.
- The recipient of the scholarship will, if required, take part in publicity activities as required by the Eastland Wood Council. These are usually restricted to photo opportunity on announcement of the scholarship award.
- Eastland Wood Council may vary these regulations at any time.
