- Potential to contribute to the forestry industry in the Eastland region

APPLICATION PROCESS

- Submit the application on the form, attaching any supporting information.
- Applicants may be required to attend an interview (this can be via skype or phone.)
- Applications close at 5.00pm 31st October 2020

SCHOLARSHIP REGULATIONS

- Eastland Wood Council is not obliged to offer a scholarship if, in any year, there is no candidate of sufficient merit.
- The recipient of the scholarship will, if required, take part in publicity activities as required by the Eastland Wood Council. These are usually restricted to photo opportunity on announcement of the scholarship award.
